Vitamins

- § Nutrigel or Energel daily (available from Vet)
- § Your kitten has Been worm treated (good idea to worm every 3 months) also Frontline flea treated
- § Our kitten must be vaccinated for flue and feline enteritis at 12 weeks and second injection at 16 weeks

Desexing

We recommend desexing between 4 and 6 months if kitten as not already been desexed.

Sanitary Tray

Your kitten is litter trained and is accustomed to using sawdust or Breeders Choice kitty litter.
